

## **Current situation regarding Corona**

### **Current information from the Munich Foreigners Authority (Ausländerbehörde München):**

- **What are the opening hours of the Foreigners Authority?**  
The Foreigners Authority (Ruppertstraße 19 and Seidlstraße 27) and the Naturalisation Office (Bavariastraße 7a) will be closed from 17.03.
- **What about booked appointments?**  
Booked appointments have been or will be cancelled.
- **What if my residence permit and work permit expire soon? Are there emergency appointments, can fictional certificates be requested in writing and issued by fax?**  
If the residence permit, permit, visa, residence card or fictional certificate is about to expire, the Foreigners Authority will send a certificate by post. This confirms that the document confirming your residence status in Germany remains valid until the Foreigners Authority opens again. This also applies to other regulations such as permission to work.
- **How do I contact someone at the Foreigners Authority?**

### **BaMF:**

- According to media information, interviews in the revocation proceedings are currently suspended until March 29.
- Asylum application and interview in the asylum procedure is only carried out if the asylum seekers have either tested negative or can prove that they have been in quarantine for 14 days

### **Administrative Court Munich (Verwaltungsgericht München):**

- no court hearings until Tuesday 31 March 2020
- But: Incoming appeals are being processed. Urgent proceedings that do not require an oral hearing are reliably decided in due time.
- The legal aid office is open at the following times: Monday -Thursday: 08.00 -12.00 13.00 -16.00 Friday: 08.00 -12.00
- The legal request offices in the outposts of the Anker centres are not occupied at present. If possible, a written complaint must be submitted.
- **ATTENTION:** in some cases the court will send requests to abstain from the oral proceedings when cancelling the appointment. So look at the letters carefully and insist on an oral hearing (in writing)! A decision without an oral hearing is rarely advantageous.

**Lawsuits and legal request office**

- In Munich, the legal request office at Bayerstr. 30 is open. In some branch offices, e.g. Manching, they are closed. At the places where the legal request offices are closed, you should try to file a written complaint. The address of the responsible court can be found on one of the last pages of the notice.
